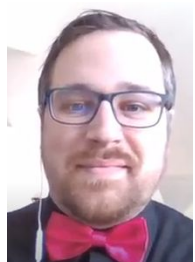
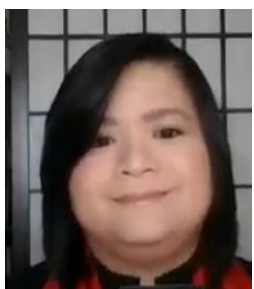
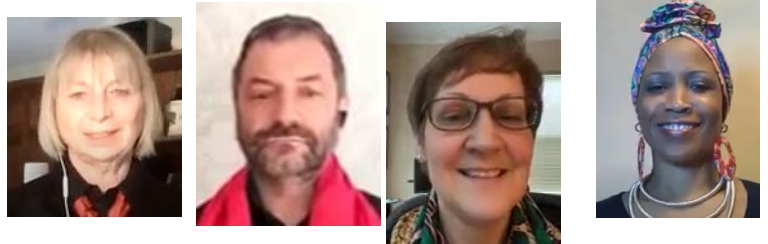
“This is the Day” for another virtual performance!

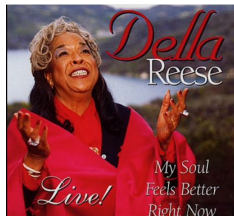
