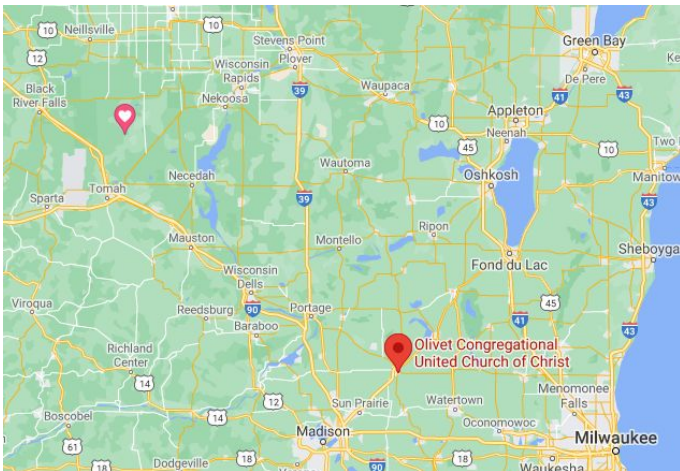

A few questions about our return to singing have come up in our virtual gatherings. To clarify:

1. When we return to singing f2f, *everyone who attends rehearsal must be fully vaccinated*. We do understand that some of us have medical conditions that prevent vaccination. For now, we cannot safely encourage those people to attend rehearsals.
2. Even with vaccinations, we will be observing physical distancing guidelines while singing. This means we will likely be sitting in the pews, so as to remain ca. 6 feet apart while singing.
3. Unless/until health guidelines change, *we will sing in masks*. You may want to experiment singing in different kinds of masks to see what works best for you.
