It's Women's History Month!

Add these unsung women gospel musicians to your spring playlist:

Sissieretta Jones (1868-1933): daughter of a pastor who started singing in church at age 6. She later studies at the New England Conservatory, and became world-famous for singing gospel, popular and classical music. She toured the West Indies with the Fisk Singers, and sang at the White House at least four times... even though only Theodore Roosevelt let her use the front door. Czech composer Antonín Dvořák wrote an arrangement of Old Folks at Home just for her! In 1915, "Sissi" Jones left the stage to care for her mother and an extended family that included several adopted children.



Cleotha Staples (1934-2013): A lead singer of The Staple Singers, PN (pastor's niece) Cleotha grew up in Chicago, often singing with their father at her uncle's church. She and her siblings were equally at home singing gospel, soul or R&B, and often challenged that invisible line between church music and protest

anthem. One of their many hits, "If You're Ready" includes these

lines:

If you're ready come go with me
No hatred
Will be tolerated
Peace love all between the races
Love is the only transportation
To where there's communications
If you're ready come go with me..





SistaStrings: Chauntee and Monique Ross, 2PKs (two pastors' kids) from Milwaukee who blend classical, gospel & other musical influences to tell personal stories & lift up spiritual and cultural ties across generations. They toured with Brandi Carlile in 2022, and also perform with Allison Russell's Rainbow Coalition of the Loving.
