On June 19th, 1865, Major General Gordon Granger landed at Galveston Bay, Texas. Finally, 17 days after the last Confederate troops had surrendered, Granger began *enforcing* President Lincoln's Emancipation Proclamation (signed 2½ *years* earlier!) across Texas

The people of Texas are informed that in accordance with a Proclamation from the Executive of the United States, all slaves are free. This involves an absolute equality of rights and rights of property between former masters and slaves, and the connection heretofore existing between them becomes that between employer and hired laborer.

160 years after that first Juneteenth in Galveston, June 19th reminds us to honor the resilience of enslaved persons, recall unkept promises, and recommit ourselves to justice and equal opportunity.


Left: Emancipation Day celebration, June 19, 1900 held in "East Woods" on East 24th Street in Austin, TX (Austin History Center).

Sing from-and for-your heart

Dr. Julie Kulinski (Med. College of Wisconsin) recently completed a clinical trial on the impact of singing on older adults' cardiovascular health. The researchers noted that:



- a) less than ¼ of eligible medicare beneficiaries complete even 1 session of prescribed cardiac rehab
- b) persons with arthritis, chronic obstructive disease, or neuropathy (limb numbness) are even less likely to complete cardiac rehab.
- c) singing is a physical/aerobic activity that impacts the vagal nerves & heart.
- d) <u>prior research</u> showed that just *14 minutes* of singing (regardless of musical ability!) improves vascular function.

In this clinical trial, 65 older adults with coronary artery disease completed 3 study visits:

- 1. 30 min. of live singing with a music therapist, or
- 2. 30 min. of singing along to an instructional video, or
- 3. 30 min. of rest (control).

<u>Results</u> show that singing–especially singing along to a practice video–has a statistically significant effect on microvascular function.
